Full Day City & Fatepur Sikri Tour	<p align="center"><b>FULL DAY CITY TOUR AND FATEHPUR SIKRI</b></p> <p>Sightseeing tour of Agra city includes visits to the world famous Taj Mahal and Agra Fort. Taj Mahal - one of the wonders of the world - is a monument of love created by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal and perhaps the most perfect architectural monument of the world. Agra Fort - the red sand stone fort is a testament to the rise and fall of the Mughal Empire built by Emperor Akbar over 400 years ago. Fatehpur Sikri, is the deserted capital of Emperor Akbar, approximately 35 kilometres outside Agra. Built in the 16th century, this city was abandoned 12 years later due to a scarcity of water. The entire city of Red sand stone (sand stone palaces and temples) is virtually intact and a site worth seeing is the 54 metre high main entrance -- The Buland Darwaza, The gate of victory constructed to commemorate Akbar's victory in Gujarat.</p>	INR4468.75

One of the major attractions in the museum is the portion known as the 'Armory Museum', which houses an impressive selection of weaponry-pistols, swords, rifles and daggers. **COCHIN CITY TOUR – HALF DAY**

Duration: approximately 4 hours

Cochin City Tour

This harbour city presents a contrast of sorts with its British, Dutch, Portuguese, Chinese and Jewish influence. City tour takes you to the Cochin harbour terminus where the Chinese fishing nets present a wonderful sight. Mattancherry Dutch palace - built by the Portuguese and presented to The Raja of Cochin in 1555. The Jewish synagogue - built in 1568, destroyed by the Portuguese in 1662 and rebuilt by the Dutch two years later, St Francis church - the oldest Protestant church built in 1510, Vasco Da Gama who died in 1524, was buried here.
